The history of the concept of the devil goes back for a long time. The important thing to understand about the dark ages is that ideals like freedom of religion and not going to war with people and Countries because of their religious beliefs were not a social norm during the dark ages or any time before that. It was a very common practice to blame "the devil" as a means of justifying political agendas and wars against other Countries.

The history of Christianity starts of course with Jesus Christ. The legacy continues into the times of Charlemagne in the dark ages. During these times there were no printing presses used to copy scripture so scriptures were copied by hand. At this point any person of any social status was allowed to join the church and would be taught literacy in order to read and write and copy documentation such as scripture. In fact Charlemagne's primary motivation in funding the Church was to promote literacy within his kingdom.

The basic "rule of thumb" we find in Charlemagne's time was that when priests copied scripture they often changed basic principles of teachings, laws and philosophies found within the scriptures, but were not allowed to change the main story lines. They would often write philosophies and concepts into the margins of the story line. The only documented change of the story-line was the story of "let he who is without sin throw the first stone" in which Jesus prevents the stoning of a prostitute. This was initially written into the margin as a philosophy and accidentally added in several transcriptions later as part of the story line.

What did the disciples really teach and preach as far as philosophies and teachings? We will never know, as ancient manuscripts dictate. All we know for sure is that there were thousands of "books" out of the currently included 27 found in the modern cannon of the New Testament today and that many of these manuscripts not only taught different philosophies and teachings, but also contradicted each other on the nature of what the correct philosophies and teachings were.

Charlemagne successfully saved Christianity from extinction leaving the many copies of contradicting manuscripts behind, and being the last surviving Christian empires leaving only his behind. Skip backward into the past about 5 Centuries to the rule of Constantine, Emperor or Rome. An Emperor is the only rank that outranks a king and is what the reference "King of Kings" refers to in scripture. Constantine basically got tired of the fact the pagans and the Christians were constantly murdering each other, because this created a lot of conflict inside his kingdom. He wanted peace within his own kingdom at the very least and he needed to choose a side to end this conflict.

The pagans of course were teaching that the Christian god was the devil, and the Christians were likewise doing the same. Both, emboldened by the holy quest were content to murder the other based on the idea their opposing religion's deity was actually a demon.

For whatever reason Constantine chose Christianity, and not on his deathbed as people sometimes claim. At this point it was declared that anyone who refused to convert to Christianity was to be punished with death (and allegedly damnation.) This gave rise to the Roman Catholic Church who carried on this tradition with any Countries that allied with them.

Now one thing you have to understand about the dark ages is that there were no weekends, and people usually worked 10 to 12 hours a day. The common man had no days off and the nobles and higher class only had off holidays, also working long days and weekends. As you might imagine people who worked this long and this hard treasured their holidays which held even more value than today as they were the only days off.

As a means to pacify the pagans Constantine declared the pagans could keep their holidays on the condition they converted them into Christian themes. Almost all modern Christian holidays are actually pagan holidays with the traditions, concepts, deities, and symbols converted into Christian themes. When pagans say Christians "stole" their holidays this is what they refer to.

Set with this foundation the Roman Catholic Church quickly gained power and a foothold on this world. They continued on the proud tradition of making not converting to their religion punishable by death. Any deity or followers of deities who refused to convert to the Christian faith or acknowledge the Christian God as it's true god and ruler was exterminated in any Country that allied themselves with the Roman Catholic Church under the guise that their gods were all demons or sometimes fallen angels.

The Roman Catholic Church ruled and reigned for a long time using the excuse of the devil to justify a great many things. If a woman felt she had the right to choose who she married, or was somehow equal to a man she was accused of witchcraft, tortured until she confessed to witchcraft to stop the suffering and then burned at the stake.

One famous such women was Joan of Arc who is acknowledged as not being schizophrenic in history but claimed to hear and respond to the voice of Archangel Gabriel. There is some conflict behind people claiming no one tried to rape her, but you have to understand in this time it was illegal for women to choose who they marry. When a man tried to marry her against her will there was no "I do" on her end required to seal the deal and not letting her husband have sex with her after the unwanted marriage was forced on her was also punishable by death. In modern society a man forcing a woman to marry her and have sex with her against her will would have been called rape. In her time it was not considered such.

Anyway for literally being a feminist and refusing to accept marrying a man against her will Joan of Arc was tortured and burned as a witch. The lie of the devil was commonplace since it was the logical justification for the only conceivable reason why a woman would rebel against a man's authority like this under Catholic rule. Joan of Arc is remembered crying out to God to forgive the people murdering her while she burned alive.

In addition to the devil being a lie to punish women who felt they deserved women's rights the devil is most historically know to be used as a lie to punish people who refuse to accept the Christian religion as real, and also to justify the murder of any Christians who refuse to conform to the Roman Catholic Church's authority.

One famous such example is Pan, from the Greek religion. There are no references to the devil having cloven hooves, a face like a goat, and horns in any modern text of the modern cannon of the Bible (Old Testament and New Testament.) The reason the devil is portrayed in this way is that the Roman Catholic Church had a problem with the Pan worshipers being more popular than their particular religion so they remolded the devil to look like Pan, told their followers this was the image of the devil and let things play out as the Christian Warriors discovered Pan and then exterminated all the Pan Worshipers.

In addition to demonizing any religion that opposed The Roman Catholic Church external to the Abrahamic faiths (religions which claim to be a true religion of the god of Abraham – primarily Islam, Christianity and Judaism) and the demonization of women who insisted on being what in modern day is called a feminist, The Roman Catholic Church would also murder Christians who did not submit to their authority.

A classic example of this is Pope Perfect who sent a messenger to the Kathers commanding them to give to him a book of black magick that he wanted. The Kathers refused on account of the fact they were afraid the Pope would misuse the book. As a result of this action over 10,000 Kathers were burned alive along with their book of black magick inside their fortress for no other crime than wanting to keep their property and insulting a messenger. They are also remembered as refusing to show any signs of pain or complaint, burning in silence as they died, though this part may not be fully accurate.

An important lesson is remembered in the Knight's Templar. The Knight's Templar served The Roman Catholic Church in the Crusades. During the Crusades people are told this was a war between the Catholic Church and the Muslims, but it's important to remember at this time any religion external to the Abrahamic Faiths at this point lumped all together in the word "pagan" that the Crusaders on either side came across was also exterminated. The rise of both Christianity and Islam did not come to be popular over philosophical debate, proof of miracles, or any other form of credibility but simply by murdering all the other religions of the earth that refused to submit to them.

After the Crusades the Knight's Templar became one of the most powerful military forces in the world by establishing the world's first international banking system. This was the fabled treasure of the Knight's Templar, not some secret storage of gold. The people who own the International Banking system are the ones who stole their treasure as without their extermination it would still belong to the Knight's Templar. At this point The Roman Catholic Church became afraid of the Knight's Templar, because they knew their enforcement of political views under the guise of religion might go instead to this other Christian organization that had become the more wealthy, influential and powerful than them.

The Catholic Church decided to murder the Knight's Templar, but a lie was needed here. The lie of the devil took the form of Baphomet this time. Baphomet is a fictional demon that does not in any way show up in all of recorded history until the exact moment it is time to murder the Knight's Templar for worshiping him. Various different pagan deities combined may have inspired the creation of Baphomet, but Baphomet as a whole was literally a lie created to justify the assassination of the Knight's Templar.

Notices were sent out to all the branches of the Catholic Church that were not to be opened until a specific day which was Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>. On that day the clergy of the Roman Catholic Church all opened their notices where they were told the lie of Baphomet and assigned to murder the Knight's Templar for worshiping him. It is said Friday the 13<sup>th</sup> is lucky for witches (or any other religion persecuted by Christians) or people whose actions reflect the Templar Codes, but unlucky for everyone else for this reason.

This is especially relevant for anyone who remembers the Satanist group who got the 10 commandments removed for a government building by suing the government to either remove the 10 commandments or place their statue of Baphomet up there with them on grounds of separation of Church and state. This is especially fitting for a group of satanic atheists to use this particular fictional demonic deity for this task.

Of course it was during the time of Charlemagne that many books were changed but, with the exception to one story, none of the plot lines present in the New Testament were changed. It's important to remember however that out of these 10s of thousands of different books, the Catholics destroyed a majority of them. The ones they kept are stored in the Vatican archives and are not available to non-clergy unless an exception is made by the Catholic Church.

Some of these books supported things like woman's rights, encouraged things like the ideals Christianity could work in harmony with other religions rather than killing them. Some books like The Biblical Apocrypha challenged the ideal that Jesus of Nazareth was even part of the Judaic religion and others like The Gospel of Thomas laid claims that contradict the idea Thomas was a traitor and was in fact Jesus's closest friend who arranged his assassination as part of an agreement with him. Both of these books referenced can be found online, although their destruction was attempted. Countless other potential books of scripture were destroyed along with their followers on the claim of heresy. A Gnostic (like the Kathers mentioned earlier) was a person who believed something different than what The Roman Catholic Church taught including the Catholic Church's thinly veiled political beliefs justified in the name of Jesus and were considered heretics punishable by death.

At a certain point after all these things had taken place a Catholic clergyman called Martin Luther (not to be confused with Martin Luther King) accidentally sparked the protestant revolution. He did this by posting a thesis on the door of a church intended for the clergy there which fell into the hands of the common people by accident. This document contained changes in The Roman Catholic Church he wanted done, and in the hands of the common people ended up sparking a revolution.

Out of all the changes he wanted there are two which should be pointed out. The first is that the Catholic Church would constantly tell everyone they were going to hell for their sins and the only way to escape hell was forgiveness. Forgiveness was obtained by giving The Roman Catholic Church money. For at least Centuries forgiveness was never free. For this reason it was often said the poor would be more virtuous than the rich since the poor could not afford to buy forgiveness from the Church as the rich could.

Another one of the things in the thesis that Martin Luther was requested was that the common people be given access to Christian scripture. Out of this rose the modern cannon of the The New Testament and The Old Testament. In should be noted the 27 "books" of The New Testament and the books of the Old Testament in the modern cannon are not all of the books of the Bible held by the Roman Catholic Church. The Roman Catholic Church still has thousands of books in their bible that non-clergy are not usually allowed access too, and this is not even counting the mass extermination of Gnostics and their books which contradicted the political and religious beliefs and agendas of The Roman Catholic Church.

Out of the books they were given the newly formed protestants had numerous manuscripts to consider to try to decide which the 27 books of the New Testament were accurate, and just as in Charlemagne's time these manuscripts all contradicted each other on numerous points. A council met, decided which beliefs were right and to be frankly they disposed of a lot of the content and just made their own reality. This formed the modern cannon of The New Testament in which we have no way of knowing which teachings are accurate or what other thousands of books in existence kept secret by The Catholic Church are excluded or the tens of thousands of books said that the Catholics destroyed which obviously contradicted the ones currently considered the modern bible by Christians. To be clear the compilation of the modern cannon took place during this council, not during the King's James Version of the Bible. This was the first time the modern cannon of The New and Old Testament appeared.

Some important points to take away from this is that free forgiveness is not an original Christian teaching. Your modern bibles may indicate that it is, but as I've clearly demonstrated this version of the modern cannon was formed at the time in which the change for free forgiveness instead of paying clergy for forgiveness was also formed. History tells us not when paid forgiveness starts, but that it was a traditional teaching of forgiveness much older than the modern cannon.

The records of Martin Luther's thesis reveal historically that forgiveness was not free at the same time before the modern cannon was first written, so scripture and history contradict each other here since the modern cannon was written to conform to this new system of free forgiveness. It makes a lot of sense in the dark ages to charge people money for sinning, because when most people don't have a disposable income it encourages compatibility with the sin system.

Another point to take into consideration when a Christian tells you about "Traditional Christian Marriage" is that women are not supposed to be allowed to choose who they marry. This is up to their parents or if dead up to whatever man claims her. She does not say "I do" during a ceremony and is considered property having no legal right to refuse sex to a man. The original reason for a best man at a marriage is to serve as a bodyguard to prevent someone from stealing the bride and marrying her themselves since women are considered property. Keep this in mind when people argue about "traditional marriage" being contradicted by homosexual marriage. There is no such thing as traditional marriage anymore, and frankly that is a good thing.

In addition to these specific demonization of everyone who opposes The Roman Catholic Church, from any religion that refuses to submit to their God, from any Christian who refuses to submit to their dogma, and from any Christian has too much power over them even in submitting to them we see some other correlations of the devil is a lie that go back further into Judaism.

While Christianity and Islam are far more frequently the oppressors in the modern world we see signs of oppression against other religions that dates as far back as Judaism. Ningishzida is a pagan deity from the Babylonian religion whose symbol is the snake and guards the tree of knowledge in the garden of paradise.

In the story of Genesis we see a snake in front of a tree of knowledge of good and evil who teaches mankind morality, This is suspiciously similar to Ningishzida. We also see various Babylonian gods named directly as demons in the Judaic scriptures. Other correlations are seen such as in religions like the Sumerian religion in which the concept of angels may have actually originated. Some historians may argue the Sumerian religion predates the Judaic one and that Cuneiform, the language of the Sumerians is a root language predating the Hebrew language.

In ancient times heaven simply meant "that which is above the earth" and it was believed heaven referred to this in ancient times even into the Renaissance until humanity discovered the earth was round and above it was outer space. At this point people knew what was above the earth wasn't the heaven described so humanity changed heaven to mean some mystical realm, but in the time our ancient scriptures were written in always meant above the earth. In the Sumerian religion angels appeared from heaven (outer space) in ships, and mined the earth for gold.

We now know that gold is the strongest conduit of electricity out of all the elements on this planet and this story would explain not only why angels that literally came from out of space would find it valuable for ships that travel through outer space because of it's function for electrical components. This also explains the scarcity of gold on this planet which gives it such a high inherent value.

Other religions also have angels in them, but this one is especially relevant as Enki is an angel from the Sumerian religion which may have predated the Judeo-Christian religion often portrayed as "Lucifer." It's possible the idea of angels did not even originate from the Judaic religion.

Of course the followers of the Sumerian and Babylon religions which are constantly indirectly and sometimes directly demonized in the Judaic scriptures have all been exterminated. New people have reformed these religions, but of course most scriptures and real history have been lost in the ancient holy wars in a time in which the demonization of another religion always served the same purpose.

The main lesson here is that when we say the devil is a lie what we mean is that people need a lie. A lie is needed to enforce genocide and murder the followers of another religion. That lie always has been the devil. The way of the dark ages is to demonize any other religion that opposes yours, to demonize any political views that oppose yours under the guise of religion. That lie hides the ugly truth that your religion or political beliefs do not stand up against the will of your opponents be they the majority or fear that they will become the majority. The most popular lie for this is the devil.

Of course the Christians are hardly the only ones who demonize other religions. Jews consider the Christian and Islamic religion a blasphemy of theirs. Muslims and Christians both commonly consider each other's religions to be the work of Satan. This is ironic since all three of these religions are Abrahamic faiths, meaning they all claim to worship the god of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob from the Torah (part of the Old Testament) and yet they are all in conflict with each other. This conflict during the Crusades served the side purpose of eliminating most of the remaining groups of paganism of all kinds while in conflict with each other resulting in a primarily Abrahamic faith following worldwide.

Pagans (which has become a loose term for almost every other religion that isn't part of the Abrahamic faiths since the middle ages) have of course had their conflicts with each other and with the Abrahamic faiths that involve demonizing other religions as well. There is really only one mainstream (popular) religion that has managed to stay out of the holy wars (meaning not committed genocide or murder on the claim a religion is demonic) during the dark ages and beyond and that is Buddhism which has specific rules and regulations built into to the religion to maintain this sort of neutral ground relative to these constant holy wars.

This document talks a lot about the Abrahamic Faiths because this is most of the history I have studied and have to explain to you, and because The Abrahamic faiths are followed by the majority of people on this world. It should be understood however that the devil is a lie applies to other religions as well.
